**JUDICIAL SUPERVISION PROGRAM (JSP) INFORMATION SHEET (07/01/09)**

- Casa de los Niños is the current contract holder for JSP services. They are the only agency providing specific JSP services under a contract with the Court. There are private providers which litigants may use for supervised services. Private providers are not monitored by the court, do not receive an administrative fee from the court for their services and their fees may not be subsidized by the Court. Contact information for the contract provider, Casa de los Niños is listed below.
- JSP services through Casa de los Niños only provides services to families referred by a court order entered in a family law case. Services through JSP will not commence without an order from the court. The order should include what services are being ordered i.e., supervised exchanges, supervised visits, therapeutic supervision and who will be responsible for payment of the services. The order should also indicate that the parties must schedule an intake appointment with JSP within 14 days of the Court order. Services will not be implemented until an intake appointment by each party is completed absent extraordinary circumstances. The JSP program should be faxed or mailed a copy of any Court orders involving JSP.
- In order for a judge sitting on the Juvenile Bench to order JSP services, there must be a family law case consolidated with the dependency matter.
- In order for a judge to order the use of the court's subsidized funding source for this service, prior permission must be obtained from the Presiding Judge of the Family Law Bench.

As of July 1, 2008, the fees for JSP services through Casa de los Niños are as outlined below. These fees are determined by the Court and cannot be changed by the provider.

| Supervised exchanges:      | \$30 <u>Total</u> (\$15 per exchange)<br>An exchange is defined as one parent dropping off the child(ren) and the other parent picking up the child(ren).   |
| Supervised Parenting Time: | \$40 First hour; \$20 Additional hours.   |
| Telephone Monitoring:      | Same as Supervised Parenting Time but pro-rated for actual length of the telephone call.  |
| Therapeutic Supervision:   | \$90/hour.  |
| No Shows/Cancellations:    | A charge which equals the amount of the service that was to be provided may be charged to the party if a 24-hour advance notice of cancellation is not given. If the Court is subsidizing a party that does not adhere to the 24-hour advance cancellation notice, the Court will not be responsible for this fee. The party will be required to pay. |
