- I. **Introductions:** All attendees had the opportunity to introduce themselves. Cheryl Russell reviewed how this group came to fruition. It evolved after the conference held in Phoenix in September *"Connecting the Dots, Domestic Violence-Child Welfare, One State, One System"* and the recognition of the Model Court Working Committee and PCJCC to identify domestic violence as an initiative. Specifically, the Model Court Working Committee will address Education, Assessment and Intervention.

 - b. What is our focus more specifically:
 - Who exactly are we educating?
 - Need for providers working with parents
 - What training or resources is already in the community?
 - Court Wide training is limited
 - CPS CORE training may not address the criminal side
 - CPSA has free training but what is included
 - ***How to identify domestic violence***
 - Look at other models around the country i.e. Dade County
 - c. Everyone agreed to look at their own agencies and what they are providing to educate and who the collaborators are within their agency.

After a lively discussion it was agreed that the committee needs focus and direction. John Jackson suggested that the committee chairs meet with Judge Adam, Brenda Flynn and Lillian Downing to assist with the focus.
